## ORDINANCE NO. 214

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, REGULATING THE SPEED OF MOTOR TRUCKS OR VEHICLES UPON THE PUBLIC HIGHWAYS IN SAID CITY AND PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That it shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to operate a motor truck or vehicle having a capacity greater than one and one-half tons upon any public highway within said City except that portion of the Causeway not embraced in the viaduct or bridge in said Causeway at a rate of speed greater than fifteen miles per hour, but this ordinance shall not repeal ordinance No. 180, adopted June 21, 1922.

Section 2. That any person, firm or corporation found guilty of the violation of this ordinance shall be fined not exceeding Two Hundred Dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail not exceeding ninety days.
