

ORDINANCE NO. 217

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA,
CREATING THE OFFICE OF POLICE SER-
GEANT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:

SECTION 1.

That the office of police sergeant to be filled by
some police officer of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, whose
duties shall be perscribed by the Chief of Police of said City
and who shall be subordinate to said Chief of Police, be and
the same is hereby created.

SECTION 2.

An officer to fill such ordinance shall be appointed
by the Mayor whose appointment shall be confirmed by the City
Council.


