

ORDINANCE NO. 218

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, REGULATING THE HOURS DURING WHICH VEHICLES DRAWN BY ANIMALS, POWER PROPELLED ROLLERS AND TRUCKS CARRYING HEAVY MACHINERY OR OTHER MATERIAL AT A SPEED NOT GREATER THAN TEN MILES PER HOUR MAY USE THE CAUSEWAY BETWEEN MIAMI AND MIAMI BEACH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1.

That during the time between seven-thirty and ten A.M. and three o'clock and six-thirty P. M., no vehicle drawn by an animal or animals, no power propelled roller and no truck or other vehicle carrying heavy machinery or other material at a speed not greater than ten miles per hour shall use the causeway between Miami and Miami Beach, Florida, for a passage-way.

Section 2.

That any person, firm or corporation found guilty of a violation of this ordinance shall be fined not exceeding \$200.00 or be imprisoned in the City Jail not exceeding ninety days.

Section 3.

That all ordinances or ~~parts~~ thereof in direct conflict herewith are hereby repealed.


