BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That Section 8 of Ordinance No. 195 passed and adopted October 17th, 1923, be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Section 8: All confirmed cripples, all invalids physically incapable of manual labor shall be allowed a license for any of the above mentioned occupations without charge so long as they use their own capital and their profits are not divided with someone else and when in the opinion of the Collector of taxes, such applicants are worthy.
