

ORDINANCE NO. 230

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, PRESCRIBING THE SALARY
TO BE PAID THE MUNICIPAL JUDGE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the salary of the Municipal Judge
of the City of Miami Beach is hereby prescribed and autho-
rized as \$200.00 per month, beginning November 1st, 1925.

Section 2: That that portion of Ordinance No. 227,
passed heretofore and in conflict herewith is hereby re-
pealed.

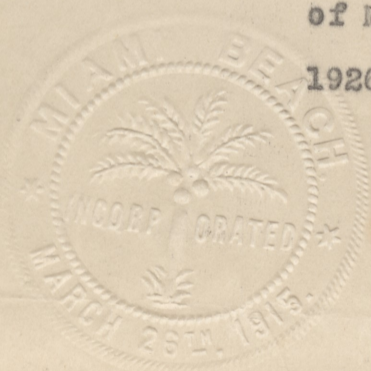
