AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY MARSHAL AND THE CITY TAX ASSESSOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

That the salary of the City Marshal, or Chief Section 1: of Police, from and after January 14th, 1926, shall be at the rate of \$5,000.00 per year payable in twelve equal monthly installments.

That on and after February 1st, 1926, the salary of the City Tax Assessor shall be at the rate of \$3,900.00 per year payable in twelve equal monthly installments.

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in Section 3: conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall become effective immediate-Section 4: ly after its passage and adoption and posting as required by law.
