

ORDINANCE NO. 238


AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, FIXING THE SALARY OF THE
CHIEF OF POLICE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the salary of the Chief of Police of
said City shall be \$4,000.00 per year, payable in twelve equal
installments on the first day of each month.

Section 2: That all ordinances or parts of ordinances
in conflict herewith, are hereby repealed.


