

ORDINANCE NO. 241

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO RE-
GISTRATION AND VOTING IN THE
CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

1. That it shall be unlawful for any person to register as a voter of said City who is not at the time a bona fide resident of said City and entitled to register as such voter in accordance with the laws of the State of Florida and the laws and ordinances of said City.

2. That it shall be unlawful for any person who has violated the foregoing provisions of this Ordinance, or who has unlawfully registered as such voter, to vote at any election conducted pursuant to the laws and ordinances applicable to or of said City.

3. That the Supervisor of Registration may require such identification and certification of registration as he may deem proper.

4. That it shall be unlawful for any person to aid, advise or abet another to violate any provision of this Ordinance.

5. This ordinance shall be effective instanter.

6. That it is apparent that a number of persons have registered and anticipate registration in the near future in said City for the purpose of voting at the General City Election to be held therein during December, 1926, and that such an emergency exists for the welfare of the citizens of said City that this Ordinance be given its three readings at this meeting.

7. That any person who violates any provision of this Ordinance shall be fined not exceeding \$200.00 and or be imprisoned not exceeding 90 days.



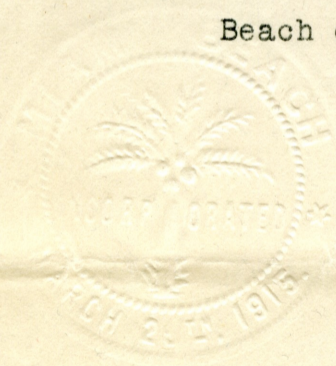
