MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:


Section 1: That the salaries, as fixed by the follow-

Water Superintendent	\$4,800.00 " "


the above salaries to be effective January 1st, 1927.

hereby repealed.



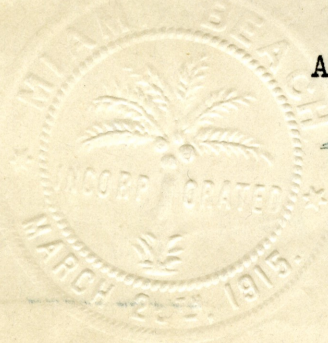


