ORDINANCE NO. 246

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, FIXING THE SALARIES OF THE CITY AUDITOR, CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE CHIEF OF THE FIRE DEPARTMENT. WATER SUPERINTENDENT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the salaries, as fixed by the following schedule, be paid in twelve monthly installments on the first of each and every month:

City Auditor \$4,500.00 per year Chief of Police \$5,000.00 Chief of Fire Department \$5,000.00 Water Superintendent \$4,800.00 the above salaries to be effective January 1st, 1927.

Section 2: All ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.
