

ORDINANCE NO. 252

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, CHANGING THE NAME OF OUIMET AVENUE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That that certain Street or Avenue shown and designated as "Ouiquet Avenue" on Plats designated as follows: Amended Plats of Blocks A, B and F of Fair Green Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 39; Resubdivision of Blocks C, D and E of Fair Green Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book 4, Page 154; Orchard Subdivision No. 1, recorded in Plat Book 6, Page 111; Orchard Subdivision No. 2, recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 116; Orchard Subdivision No. 3, recorded in Plat Book 8, Page 116; Orchard Subdivision No. 4, recorded in Plat Book 25, Page 30; and Surprise Lake Subdivision, recorded in Plat Book 9, Page 114; which Plat Books are matters of public record in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court of Dade County, Florida, be, and the same is hereby changed in name and shall hereafter be known as "ROYAL PALM AVENUE."



All persons, firms or corporations owning property or residing upon the foregoing Street or Avenue as re-named or designated herein are hereby required to observe the provisions of this Ordinance in designating or numbering residences or posting signs or markers which may designate the foregoing Avenue.




