

ORDINANCE NO. 255

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE CARRYING
ON OF ANY BUSINESS IN ANY STREET OR ALLEY,
OR PART THEREOF, WITHOUT THE CONSENT OF THE
OWNER WHOSE PROPERTY ABUTS ON THE STREET OR
ALLEY, EXCEPT IN A DESIGNATED ZONE, AND PRO-
VIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA:

Section 1. That on and after the passage
of this ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person,
firm or corporation to carry on any business of any
nature whatsoever in the streets or alleys of the City
of Miami Beach, Dade County, Florida, without the con-
sent of the owner whose property abuts on the street
or alley, unless such business be conducted in a place
or part of the street or alley designated by police
order.

Section 2. That any and all persons, firms,
or corporations violating the terms of this ordinance
shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine not to ex-
ceed Two Hundred Dollars (\$ 200.00), or imprisonment for
not more than sixty (60) days, or both, at the discretion
of the Municipal Judge.



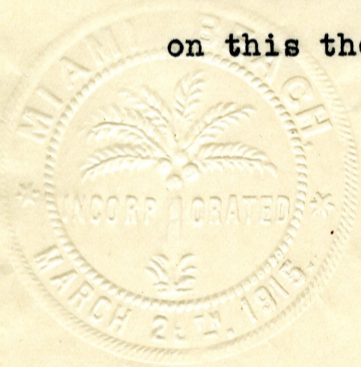
