BEACH, FLORIDA:



A. - City Manager Maximum Salary per month \$ 833.33



SECTION 2. BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED BY SAID CITY COUNCIL that said rate be effective as of November 1st, 1928.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.



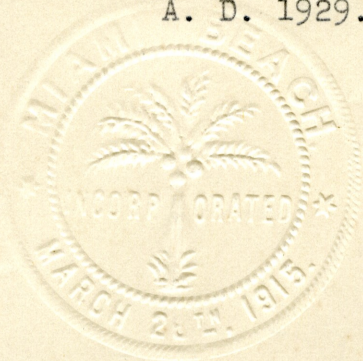
