

ORDINANCE NO. 278

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, REQUIRING FOOD HANDLERS, DRINK DISPENSERS, BARBERS, BEAUTY PARLOR OPERATORS, MAIDS AND OTHER EMPLOYEES SERVING THE PUBLIC TO OBTAIN HEALTH CERTIFICATES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: Any person or persons serving the public as food handlers, as dispensers of drinks of any kind, as barber, beauty parlor operator, manicurist, or as custodian and handler of bathing suits in a bath house or bathing pavilion and other occupations whereby the health of the public may be endangered, shall procure from a licensed and practicing physician of this County a Health Certificate every six months, which certificate shall be displayed in a conspicuous place at his place of employment.

SECTION 2: PENALTY. Any person who shall violate or fail to comply with any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, or be imprisoned in the City Jail for not more than Thirty (30) Days, or both in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3: REPEAL. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith or inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

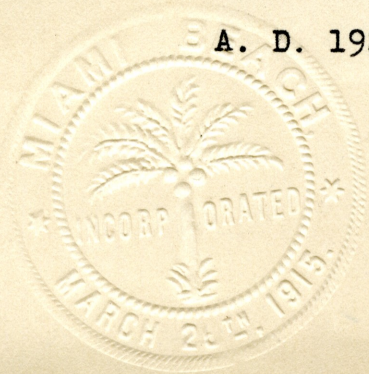
