AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING SECTION FIVE (5) "LICENSE ORDINANCE" OF ORDINANCE NO. 242 OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That that part of Section Five (5) of Ordinance No. 242 of said City entitled "Ordinance of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, imposing licenses and other taxes on privileges, businesses, occupations and professions, carried on and engaged in within said City" and prescribing penalties for the exercising of such privileges or carrying on of such businesses, occupations or professions without a license, or other failure to comply with the provisions thereof, reading as follows:

be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 2: That that part of Section Five (5) of Ordinance No. 242 of said City entitled "Ordinance of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, imposing licenses and other taxes on privileges, businesses, occupations and professions, carried on and engaged in within said City" and prescribing penalties for the exercising of professions without a license, or other failure to comply with the provisions thereof, reading as follows:

"Auctioneer, where goods, ware and merchandise are sold at auction by the owner, agent, auctioneer or other person within the limits of the City of Miami Beach, there shall be a license tax per day for each day that the sale may continue of . . \$ 50.00"

be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Auctioneer, where goods, ware and merchandise are sold at auction by the owner, agent, auctioneer or other person within the limits of the City of Miami Beach, there shall be a license tax per day for each day that the sale may continue of . . \$100.00"

SECTION 3: That this ordinance be effective from and after approval and posting as required by law.
