

ORDINANCE NO. 282

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING HOTELS, BOARDING HOUSES AND APARTMENT HOUSES FROM PAYING TO DRIVERS OF OMNIBUSSES, TAXICABS OR OTHER VEHICLES FOR TRANSPORTATION OF PASSENGERS, ANY COMPENSATION FOR DIVERTING PROSPECTIVE PATRONS OF A GIVEN HOTEL, BOARDING HOUSE OR APARTMENT HOUSE, TO ANY OTHER HOTEL, BOARDING HOUSE OR APARTMENT HOUSE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: The term "Person" is hereby declared to include individuals, corporations and partnership associations engaged in the Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House business, and also any driver of an Omnibus, Taxicab or other vehicle used for the transportation of passengers or otherwise, upon the diverting of prospective patrons of a given Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House to any other Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House.


SECTION 2: That it shall be unlawful for any person engaged in the Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House business in the City of Miami Beach, to pay to any driver of an Omnibus, Taxicab or other vehicle used for the transportation of passengers or otherwise, any compensation for diverting prospective patrons of a given Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House, to any other Hotel, Boarding House or Apartment House.

SECTION 3: This ordinance is declared to be necessary as a Police Protective Measure.


SECTION 4: Any person or persons, and the members of any firm or corporation violating the provisions of any section of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine not exceeding \$ 100.00, or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 5: That it is hereby determined and declared that the welfare of said City and the protection of the citizens thereof, require that this Ordinance be given its first, second and third readings at this meeting in one session of said City Council, which three readings of this Ordinance shall be had at this meeting, whereupon the same shall become effective immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor of said City.

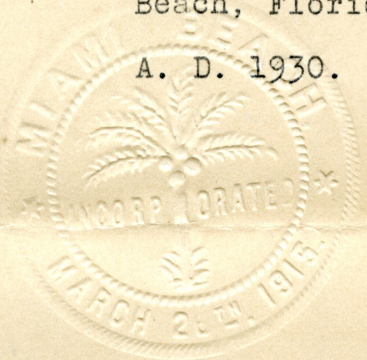
