

ORDINANCE NO. 283

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF
MIAMI BEACH, REGULATING THE
HANDLING, STORAGE AND SALE
OF CERTAIN FOODS IN THE CITY
OF MIAMI BEACH, AND PROVIDING
PENALTIES FOR ITS VIOLATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:


SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person to sell or to
expose for sale any meat or meat preparation whether
such meat or meat preparation be raw or prepared for human con-
sumption which is falsely represented to be kosher or to have
been prepared under and of a product or products sanctioned by
the Orthodox Hebrew religious requirements; or to falsely represent
any food product or the contents of any package or container to
be so constituted and prepared by having or permitting to be
inscribed thereon the word "Kosher" in any language; or to sell
or to expose for sale in the same place of business both kosher
and non-kosher meat or meat preparations either raw or prepared
for human consumption unless his window signs bear the words
"kosher" and non-kosher meat sold here" in block letters at least
four (4) inches in height; or to expose for sale in any show wind-
ow or place of business both kosher and non-kosher meat or meat
preparations, either raw or prepared for human consumption, unless
there is displayed over each kind of meat or meat preparation so
exposed a sign specifying plainly and conspicuously "kosher meat"
or "non-kosher meat" as the case may be.

SECTION 2: PENALTIES AND PROCEDURE ON ARREST. Any person who
shall violate or fail to comply with any of the
provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not
less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Two Hundred (\$200.00)
Dollars, or be imprisoned for not more than Ninety (90) days,
or both, in the discretion of the Court.

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict
herewith are hereby repealed.

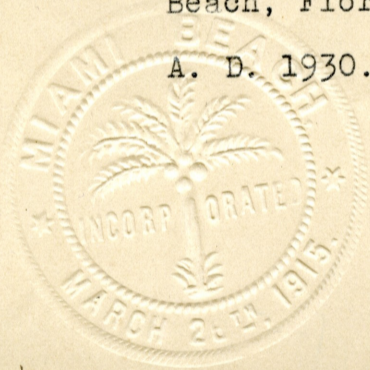
