

ORDINANCE NO. 284

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE
CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, MAKING IT
UNLAWFUL TO FISH FROM ANY VIADUCT OR
BRIDGE IN THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLOR-
IDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY
OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That it shall be unlawful for any person
to fish from any viaduct or bridge with-
in the City of Miami Beach, Florida.

SECTION 2: That any person found guilty of violation
of this ordinance shall upon conviction
be fined not exceeding One Hundred (\$ 100.00) Dollars
or be imprisoned in the City Jail not exceeding Ninety
(90) days.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall be in effect immediate-
ly upon its becoming a law.

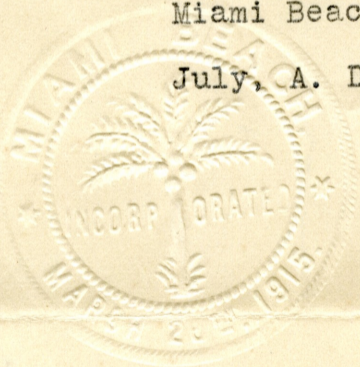
