

ORDINANCE NO. 290

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, PRESCRIBING CERTAIN SIGNS UPON THE SIDES OF CERTAIN BUSINESS VEHICLES, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That all vehicles used in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, for the purpose of solicitation of business, delivery or transportation of merchandise shall have prominently displayed upon each side thereof the name of the owner or owners and character of business in which said vehicle is engaged.

SECTION 2. Any owner or owners, driver or drivers of any vehicle described in the preceding section of this ordinance violating any of the provisions thereof shall be fined not less than Five Dollars (\$5.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00).

SECTION 3. That this ordinance shall be effective from and after approval and posting as required by law.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:



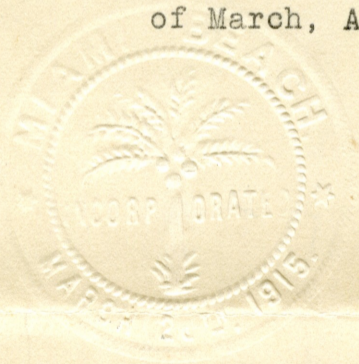


