

ORDINANCE NO. 301

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, TO REGULATE WALKING BACK AND FORTH, LOITERING AND REMAINING ON THE STREETS AND SIDEWALKS OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, IN FRONT OF BUSINESS HOUSES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERSUADING PERSONS FROM ENTERING SAID PLACES OF BUSINESS, AND TO PREVENT THE CARRYING OF SIGNS FOR SAID PURPOSES, AND FIXING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to walk back and forth, loiter or remain, or cause any person to walk back and forth, loiter or remain upon the streets or sidewalks in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, in front of any business house for the purpose of persuading any person or persons by word of mouth from entering said place or places of business for the purpose of transacting business therein.


SECTION 2: It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to walk back and forth, loiter or remain, or cause any person to walk back and forth, loiter or remain upon the streets or sidewalks, in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, in front of any business house for the purpose of persuading any person or persons by signs carried, from entering said place or places of business for the purpose of transacting business therein.

SECTION 3: Any person or persons violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be fined not more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) or imprisonment in the City jail for not more than sixty (60) days, or both in the discretion of the Court.


SECTION 4: WHEREAS an emergency exists, and the health or welfare of said City is in peril, and this Ordinance is deemed necessary for the protection of the citizens of said City, this Ordinance shall be given three (3) readings at one (1) session of said City Council, and be in full force and effect from and after the date of such passage and its approval by the Mayor.

SECTION 5: All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

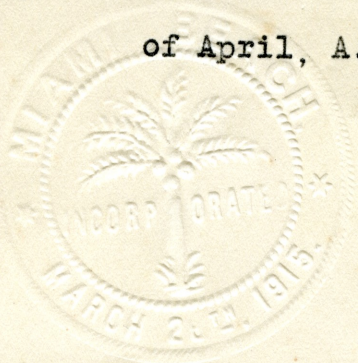


