

ORDINANCE NO. 304

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, AMENDING A PORTION OF SECTION
D, ORDINANCE NO. 256 OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That Section D, down to subdivision (a), of
Ordinance No. 256 be amended to read as fol-
lows:

"SECTION "D" - PRIVATE FIRE SERVICE PROTECTION.

1. There shall be no charge for private fire service.


The cost of the installation of Private Fire Ser-
vice is to be paid for by the owner at actual cost
plus 10%.

The Water Department shall install Fire Line con-
nections up to the property line upon the owner sign-
ing a Regular Form of Contract containing the follow-
ing conditions:"

SECTION 2: This amendment shall take effect April
First, 1932.


SECTION 3: All other parts of said ordinance shall



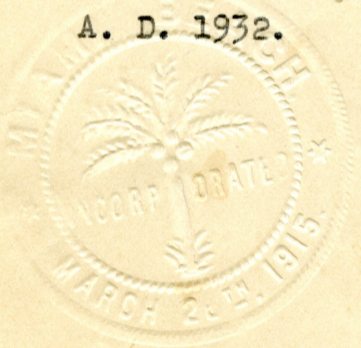
