

ORDINANCE NO. 317

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL
OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA,
AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 257 THEREOF,
AND PROVIDING FOR THE DIVISION OF
SAID CITY INTO PRECINCTS OR ELECTION
DISTRICTS AND POLLING PLACES THEREIN
FOR GENERAL ELECTIONS OF THE CITY OF
MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Sections four (4) and five (5) of Ordinance
No. 257 be and the same are hereby amended to
read as follows:

"Section 4: That for the purpose of holding and conducting
such general elections the City of Miami Beach, Florida, is
hereby divided into voting precincts or election districts
with polling places therein as follows:

PRECINCT NO. 6: That part of the City of Miami Beach located
north of Fifty-first Street, the polling place of which shall
be the BOARDWALK FILLING STATION, 6925 Collins Avenue.

PRECINCT NO. 30: That part of the City of Miami Beach South
of Fifty-first Street and north of Lincoln Road, and that part
of the Venetian Causeway which runs in an easterly and westerly
direction across what is known as the Venetian Islands, the
polling place of which shall be what is known as the LIBERTY
AVENUE FIRE STATION located on Liberty Avenue of said City.

PRECINCT NO. 31: That part of the City of Miami Beach bounded
on the south by Fifth Street and what is known as the County
Causeway, on the East by Meridian Avenue, on the north by Lin-
coln Road and the Venetian Way, and on the west by the City
limits of said City, the polling place of which shall be the
BANDSTAND IN FLAMINGO PARK of said City.

PRECINCT NO. 32: That part of the City of Miami Beach bounded
on the south by Fifth Street on the west by Meridian Avenue on
the north by Lincoln Road and on the east by the Atlantic Ocean,
the polling place of which shall be the CITY HALL of said City.


PRECINCT NO. 33: That part of the City of Miami Beach south of
Fifth Street and what is known as the County Causeway, the poll-
ing place of which shall be in the COURT ROOM OF THE POLICE
STATION on First Street of said City.

And the City Council shall appoint and designate, in accord
with Section 40 of the City Charter, three (3) inspectors and
one (1) clerk of election for each such election district or
precinct, and thereupon the Mayor or acting Mayor shall issue
his proclamation giving notice of such general election to be
held in the City of Miami Beach, which proclamation shall con-
tain a list of the officers to be voted for and the other ques-
tions to be voted upon; the places of voting; the time for
opening and closing the polls and the names of the inspectors
and clerks of election appointed as herein provided, and such
notice or proclamation shall be published once a week for a
period of four consecutive weeks next preceding such election
in a newspaper published in the City of Miami Beach, Florida,
if there be one so published, and shall be posted for the same
time in three conspicuous places in the City of Miami Beach,
Florida, and the official ballot to be used at such general elec-
tion shall be prepared by the City Council in the manner provided
by the State law.

"Section 5: That the said inspectors and clerks, or the inspectors and clerks acting in their behalf shall immediately upon the closing of the polls proceed to count the votes cast at said election in their respective precincts for each officer and the votes for and against each question therein submitted, and make out duplicate lists of the number of votes cast for each candidate at such election and the number of votes cast for and against each question voted upon, and certify the correctness of such duplicate lists, one of which shall be handed by one of said inspectors to the City Clerk of said City, and the other shall be placed in the ballot box, which shall be securely locked."


SECTION 2. All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.



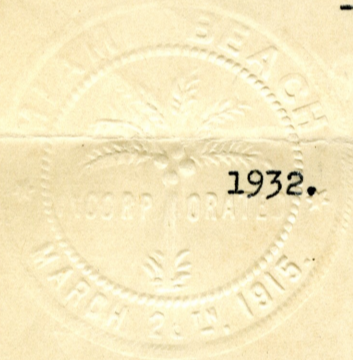
