## ORDINANCE NO. 329

AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF DEPUTIES APPOINTED BY THE CITY CLERK AND TAX COLLECTOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

That pursuant to the provisions of Sections 16 b and 17 b of the City Charter, as amended in 1933, Deputies appointed by the City Clerk and Tax Collector shall have authority to act for and in his behalf in the collection of all taxes and other revenues, with authority to administer to electors the oath required by law, and one of said Deputies shall have authority to act for and in behalf of the said City Clerk, as Clerk of the Municipal Court with authority to administer oaths and issue warrants for the arrest of persons.
