


ORDINANCE NO. 330

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING HEADLIGHT  
AND REAR-LIGHT ON BICYCLES AND  
PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR THE VIOLATION  
OF THIS ORDINANCE.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, that on or after the date of the passage  
of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any person to  
operate a bicycle upon or over the streets or public thorough-  
fares of the City of Miami Beach, during the period from one-  
half hour after sunset to one-half hour before sunrise, with-  
out having the same equipped with, and displaying on the  
front thereof, a light which can be readily distinguished for  
a distance of two hundred feet, and on the rear thereof a  
red light that can be readily distinguished for a distance  
of two hundred feet.

Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by  
a fine of not less than \$1.00 nor more than \$5.00 for each  
separate offense.


