ORDINANCE NO. 333
AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 289, BEING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF SAID CITY, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That Section 7 of said Ordinance No. 289, as amended, be amended by adding thereto immediately after the line "(4) Mortuaries", the words, "only upon approval and permit of the City Council of Miami Beach".

SECTION 2: That Section 8 of said Ordinance No. 289, as amended, be amended by adding thereto immediately after the line "(14) Fish Markets", the words, "only upon approval and permit of the City Council of Miami Beach ".

SECTION 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage, approval and posting.
