ORDINANCE NO. 340

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 289, BEING THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF SAID CITY, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1: That the paragraph defining "hotels" in Section 1 of Ordinance No. 289 of the City of Miami Beach, Florida, be amended by eliminating therefrom the words "with or without meals".

SECTION 2: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION 3: This ordinance shall take effect immediately after its passage, approval and posting in accordance with law.
