

ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA, IMPOSING LICENSES AND OTHER TAXES ON PRIVILEGES, BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS AND PROFESSIONS CARRIED ON AND ENGAGED IN WITHIN SAID CITY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE EXERCISING OF SUCH PRIVILEGES OR CARRYING ON SUCH BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS, OR PROFESSIONS, WITHOUT A LICENSE OR OTHER FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. No person, firm, corporation or association shall engage in or manage any business, privilege or occupation mentioned in this Ordinance in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, unless a City license shall have been procured from the City Clerk of said City as is provided by this Ordinance, which license shall be issued to each person, firm, corporation, or association upon the receipt of the amount herein provided for or as may otherwise be provided by law.

SECTION 2. That in every case not otherwise provided in this act, a City license tax the same as State license tax imposed by the State of Florida, be and the same is hereby levied and imposed upon such businesses, professions or occupations not otherwise specifically named in this Ordinance, and all of the penalties prescribed by this Ordinance for the non-payment of license tax or for doing business without a license, shall extend and apply to such other cases not specifically mentioned herein.

SECTION 3. No license shall be issued for more than one year and all licenses shall expire on the last day of October of each year unless otherwise provided in this act. All business licenses may be transferred with the approval of the City Clerk, with the business for which they are taken out, when there is a bona fide sale and transfer of the property used and embraced in the business so sold or transferred, but such transfer of license shall not be held good for any longer than, or at any other place than that for which it was originally issued, provided the original license shall be submitted to the said City Clerk, who shall make note thereon of the transfer thereof.

SECTION 4. All licenses shall be payable on or before the first day of November of each year and no license shall be issued for any fractional portion of a year, provided, however, that those operating businesses or occupations covered by this Ordinance who establish permanent places of business in the City of Miami Beach after July 1st may obtain a license for the remaining portion of the fiscal year upon the payment of one-half the fee provided for in this Ordinance.

SECTION 5. Each individual who acts as Agent, and each individual who acts as business or sales agent for a corporation engaged in any business mentioned in this section when his principal has not paid a license in accordance with this Ordinance, shall be required to take out a license as Agent in his own name. This section shall apply to every person who seeks, negotiates or transacts, for himself or for any other person or corporation mentioned in this Section, but not to inactive stockholders in corporation or members of agencies who do not attempt to transact any business for such agency. A license tax in the sum set opposite each of the following businesses, occupations or professions is hereby levied and imposed upon the business, occupation or profession opposite which such sum is set.

Every person, firm or corporation, selling, leasing or renting one or more marble, music or picture machines, automatic coin games or devices of skill, or other similar machines or games operated for profit, alone or in connection with any other business shall, as a pre-requisite, be required to pay a license fee as follows:

Said applicant desiring to sell, lease or rent one or more marble, music or picture machines, automatic coin games or devices of skill, or other similar machines or games operated for profit, alone or in connection with any other business, shall file with the License Department, in person if a natural person, or by the duly authorized agent or officer of the firm or corporation, a written application for a license to do business in the City of Miami Beach, Florida. Such license shall issue to the applicant and shall entitle the applicant to engage in the selling, leasing or renting of one or more machine games or devices as above described, alone or in connection with any other business, upon the payment of a license fee of TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS \$ 200.00

It is hereby understood that the foregoing provisions shall not apply to or cover automatic coin devices vending merchandise only.

It is further understood that this shall not be construed to license or permit the operation of gambling devices.

It is hereby understood that the payment of the Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars license fee for the selling, leasing or renting of one or more marble, music or picture machines, automatic coin games or devices of skill or other similar machines or games operated for profit, shall be in addition to the individual license charged by the City of Miami Beach for each machine as provided elsewhere in this Ordinance.

MERCHANTS, STORE-KEEPERS AND DEALERS

All persons, firms or corporations engaged in
the business of selling merchandise or goods of any
kind, sort or description, are required to cover their
operations by taking out a merchant's license as
follows:

CANVASSERS, ITINERANT SOLICITORS or other persons who solicit orders or sell by sample or otherwise, goods, wares, or merchandise at <u>retail</u>	250.00
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PROVIDED, however, that before any license
shall be issued to any CANVASSER, ITINERANT
SOLICITOR or other person named above, a permit
therefor must be secured from the City Manager,
application therefor having been made at least
Thirty (30) days prior to the granting of said
permit. It is hereby made the duty of said
City Manager to investigate all applications
therefor, and if said City Manager is satisfied
that the said applicant is of good moral character,
and in a legitimate business, and that the welfare
of said City will not be jeopardized by the issuance
of said license, he shall grant said permit, other-
wise not.

COLD DRINK STAND (whether operated in connection with any other business or not, such as cold drink stands in filling stations, grocery stores, etc. 5.00

DECORATIVE ARTS, POTTERY, CHINA, VASES, ORNAMENTAL IRON, GLASS AND TILE ORNAMENTS Merchant's License (as specified below.)

PAWNBROKERS selling other than articles taken on pledge, must take out a regular merchant's license. Each person or firm engaged in the business of a pawnbroker or conducting a pawn broking shop in the City, shall keep a record and upon demand shall make a report to the Chief of Police or his representative of every article or thing pawned to or purchased by him or them. Said record and report to specify the article or thing, such as number, mark, and all other such details as will make identification of such article, or such articles or things, clear and positive; and such person or persons aforesaid shall hold their shop open to visitation or inspection by the police, and upon refusal of any pawnbroker at any time to submit to such visitation or inspection, his or their shop shall be immediately closed by the order of the Mayor.

All licenses issued to pawnbrokers are subject to these provisions: Any violation of which will be punished by a revocation of their license; and no license issued to pawnbrokers shall be transferred from the person or firm to whom it was issued.

PAWNBROKER selling articles taken on pledge in addition to his regular merchant's license 250.00

SODA FOUNTAINS 15.00

Provided that SODA FOUNTAINS operated in connection with regularly licensed drug store, restaurant or confectionery store do not require a license.

PROVIDED, HOWEVER, that any such wholesale dealers in meats and poultry who solicit or take orders for and/or deliver any cleaned, drawn and/or cut poultry and/or fresh meats (excluding hindquarters, smoked meats, or fresh meats in bulk) without having a bona fide established place of business on Miami Beach shall be required to obtain a permit as provided for in the case of retail solicitors, and required to obtain separate license therefor at 250.00

WOODYARD or Firewood Dealers 10.00

MERCHANTS - All persons, firms or corporations engaged in the business of selling merchandise of any kind, sort or description, except those mentioned above under the title, "MERCHANTS, STORE-KEEPERS OR DEALERS", shall be required to pay a merchant's license tax determined as follows:

When the maximum value of stock of goods carried does not exceed One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) 25.00

For each additional One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00) or fractional part thereof 2.00

(The maximum fee depending upon the maximum value of stock of goods carried.)

LUMBER and/or Building Material dealers 50.00

RADIO AND MUSICAL INSTRUMENT DEALERS
(Separate license). Merchant's license (as specified above.)

Classified and Defined

1. Casualty and Liability Insurance Companies:
(Including Bonding Companies) writing:
 - (a) Accident and Health insurance only,
on annual, semi-annual or quarterly pre-
mium paying basis, and (b) Bonds, includ-
ing fidelity, court, contract, and surety
bonds and financial guarantees and title
insurance or guarantees.
 - (c) Burglary insurance, including resi-
dence, bank, stocks, bonds and securities,
safe burglary and hold-up and messenger
robbery.
 - (d) Liability insurance, including em-
ployers, public and other forms of liability
insurance and automobile liability for
personal injury, property damage and
collision.
 - (e) Plate glass insurance.
 - (f) Workman's collective insurance,
issued to employers of labor.

2. Fire Insurance Companies, writing policies of insurance against hazards of fire, tornado, and wind storms, use and occupancy, profits, rents, lease hold, insurrection, riot and civil commotion, sprinkler leakage, rain, fire, theft, automobile collision; and marine cargos, and hulls, and rail, mail and express shipments, against fire, collision, stranding or sinking.

3. Industrial Insurance Companies (including funeral benefit associations or companies), writing life and/or accident and health insurance and funeral benefits on a weekly, bi-monthly or monthly premium paying basis.

4. Life Insurance Companies writing Life Insurance with or without disability clauses or accident and health features as a part of the policy contract upon an annual, semi-annual or quarter-annual premium paying basis.

License to be paid by Insurance Company:

The following licenses shall be required to be paid by each Insurance Company operating in the City of Miami Beach, permitting the operation of such Insurance Company in the City of Miami Beach with any duly licensed insurance agency as provided herein; provided there shall be kept on display in a conspicuous place at such agency a permit executed by the City Clerk permitting the operation of said Company through such agency, and provided further that such permits as may be requested by a duly licensed Insurance Company shall be furnished by the City Clerk without additional cost to said Company; a separate license to be required for each separate class of insurance as defined herein, as follows:

1. Casualty and Liability Insurance Companies, each company	50.00

SECTION 6. Persons, firms or corporations operating permanently located amusement parks within which are located and operated merry-go-rounds, roller coasters and other exhibitions and performances, or other forms of diversion and amusement, except as above provided, permanently carried on in such parks, shall pay a license tax of \$100.00, provided, that this shall not be construed to apply to persons operating bathing casinos or pavillions, where guests are permitted to use swings and other devices without charge. And provided further, that this shall not apply to any person or association holding a City or County Fair, where no charge is made to persons visiting such places, and where no privileges are sold to others for the operation of shops or forms of amusement therein.

SECTION 7. Any person, firm or corporation operating, or who shall operate, a merry-go-round, roller coaster, ferris-wheel, whip, dodger, or other like or similar forms of amusement, shall pay a license in the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each of such forms of amusement where not located in a regularly licensed amusement park.

SECTION 8. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk, before issuing a license based upon property valuation or any other condition, to require the parties applying for such license to file under oath, duly authenticated, a statement of the value of the property, or other contingency, which statement shall be kept permanently on the file. A failure on the part of the City Clerk to require their said written oath, shall be cause for suspension from office. Any person who shall make a false statement, application or oath under this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished as is hereafter set forth.

SECTION 9. Any person, firm or corporation or association that shall carry on or conduct any privilege, business, occupation or profession for which a license is required by this ordinance, without first obtaining such license, and any person who shall make a false statement, application or oath, pursuant to the foregoing section, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding Ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 10. Each day that a privilege is exercised, or business, occupation, or profession conducted or followed without first having procured a license therefor, shall be an individual offense punishable as is hereinbefore set forth, provided, however, that if a person, however defined, is punished for one such offense, and pays the penalty, and procures a license before further conducting or carrying on such a privilege, business, occupation or profession, then he shall not be fined for each day's failure or omission to have a license for the conducting of such a privilege, business, occupation or profession.

SECTION 11. It shall be the duty of all officers and agents of any corporation to see that such corporation complies with the provisions of this Ordinance; and all officers or agents of any corporation required by this Ordinance to be licensed which shall do business without having paid the license tax imposed and procured such license, shall be subject to the penalties imposed by the foregoing sections upon persons and members of firms and corporations violating this Ordinance.

SECTION 12. It is hereby made the duty of the City Manager to appoint a license officer with police powers, said License Officer to investigate all the aforesaid businesses, occupations or professions, and to make such inquiry as shall be necessary to determine whether they have procured a license or licenses as is herein provided for, and shall report thereon to the City Manager and the Tax Collector on each of his investigations, and when such license or licenses shall not have been procured, to make arrest of the person or persons violating this Ordinance, and any person refusing said license officer permission to investigate and inquire for the purpose of determining whether such person has such license, shall, upon conviction be fined or imprisoned, or both fined and imprisoned, as is herein provided, for failure to procure such license.

SECTION 13. It is hereby made the duty of any person exercising the privilege or conducting a business, occupation or profession for which a license is herein required, to post his license in a conspicuous place in or about his place of business where it may be seen upon inspection by any official of said City and for his failure to do so, he shall, upon conviction, be fined or imprisoned, or both, as if he had never procured such license.

SECTION 14. The payment of a license hereunder shall not authorize or legalize in any manner whatsoever the commission of any offense or crime against said City, the County of Dade, the State of Florida, or the United States of America.

SECTION 15. No license shall be issued except in conformity with the Zoning Ordinance, No. 289, as amended.


SECTION 16. All of the provisions of this act shall be construed liberally in behalf of said City.

SECTION 17. Ordinances Nos. 311, 322, 331, 363, and all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 18. Should any section or part of this Ordinance be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, such fact shall not affect the validity of other parts thereof.


SECTION 19. This Ordinance shall become effective November 1st, 1935.



ORDINANCE NO. 394

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, IMPOSING LICENSES AND OTHER TAXES
ON PRIVILEGES, BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS AND
PROFESSIONS CARRIED ON AND ENGAGED IN WITHIN
SAID CITY, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE
EXERCISING OF SUCH PRIVILEGES OR CARRYING ON
SUCH BUSINESSES, OCCUPATIONS OR PROFESSIONS,
WITHOUT A LICENSE OR OTHER FAILURE TO COMPLY
WITH THE PROVISIONS THEREOF.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. No person, firm, corporation or association shall engage in or manage any business, privilege or occupation mentioned in this Ordinance in the City of Miami Beach, Florida, unless a City license shall have been procured from the City Clerk of said City as is provided by this Ordinance, which license shall be issued to each person, firm, corporation or association upon the receipt of the amount herein provided for or as may otherwise be provided by law.

SECTION 2. That in every case not otherwise provided in this act, a City license tax the same as State License tax imposed by the State of Florida, be and the same is hereby levied and imposed upon such businesses, professions or occupations not otherwise specifically named in this Ordinance, and all of the penalties prescribed by this Ordinance for the non-payment of license tax or for doing business without a license, shall extend and apply to such other cases not specifically mentioned herein.

SECTION 3. No license shall be issued for more than one year and all licenses shall expire on the last day of October of each year unless otherwise provided in this Act. All business licenses may be transferred with the approval of the City Clerk, with the business for which they are taken out, when there is a bona fide sale and transfer of the property used and embraced in the business so sold or transferred, but such transfer of license shall not be held good for any longer than, or at any other place than that for which it was originally issued, provided the original license shall be submitted to the said City Clerk, who shall make note thereon of the transfer.

SECTION 4. All licenses shall be payable on or before the first day of November of each year and no license shall be issued for any fractional portion of the year, provided however, that those operating businesses or occupations covered by this Ordinance who establish permanent places of business in the City of Miami Beach after May 1st, may obtain a license for the remaining portion of the fiscal year upon the payment of one-half the fee provided for in this Ordinance, provided further, if any occupation or business theretofore lawfully carried on or lawful to be carried on in the City of Miami Beach shall have been heretofore or shall hereafter at any time be prohibited and made unlawful by any Ordinance of the City of Miami Beach, then the City Clerk shall, upon application for license by or for any such business or occupation, issue a license for the fractional part of the year from November first, of the year during which application shall be made to the effective date of such Ordinance, if such effective date falls between November first of such year and October thirty-first of the succeeding calendar year, and shall collect that proportion of the license tax for such occupation or business which shall bear the same relation to the total license tax for a whole year for such occupation or business as the fractional period for which license is issued shall bear to an entire license year, and in the event a license tax for the period of a whole year shall have been or shall hereafter be collected from any person whose occupation or business has been or shall thereafter have been so prohibited and made unlawful as of a date during such year for which license tax has been collected, the City Clerk is hereby authorized to retain

such part of the license tax so collected as shall bear to the total amount so collected the same relation as the period from November first of the year of the license so issued to the effective date of such prohibitory Ordinance shall bear to the entire license year of twelve months, and is hereby authorized to refund the balance thereof to the person who shall have paid the same, and upon making such refund the City Clerk shall require the production of such license and shall endorse thereon the effective date of such prohibiting Ordinance as the expiration date of such license.

SECTION 5. Each individual who acts as Agent, and each individual who acts as business or sales agent for a corporation engaged in any business mentioned in this section when his principal has not paid a license in accordance with this Ordinance, shall be required to take out a license as Agent in his own name. This section shall apply to every person who seeks, negotiates or transacts, for himself or for any other person or corporation mentioned in this Section, but not to inactive stockholders in corporation or members of agencies who do not attempt to transact any business for such agency. A license tax in the sum set opposite each of the following businesses, occupations or professions is hereby levied and imposed upon the business, occupation or profession opposite which such sum is set.

SECTION 6. Persons, firms or corporations operating
permanently located amusement parks within
which are located and operated merry-go-rounds, roller
coasters and other exhibitions and performances, or other
forms of diversion and amusement, except as above provided,
permanently carried on in such parks, shall pay a license
tax of \$100.00, provided, that this shall not be construed
to apply to persons operating bathing casinos or pavillions,
where guests are permitted to use swings and other devices

without charge. And provided further, that this shall not apply to any person or association holding a City or County Fair, where no charge is made to persons visiting such places, and where no privileges are sold to others for the operation of shops or forms of amusement therein.

SECTION 7. Any person, firm or corporation operating, or who shall operate, a merry-go-round, roller coaster, ferris-wheel, whip, dodger, or other like or similar forms of amusement, shall pay a license in the sum of Fifty Dollars (\$50.00) for each of such forms of amusement where not located in a regularly licensed amusement park.

SECTION 8. It shall be the duty of the City Clerk, before issuing a license based upon property valuation or any other condition, to require the parties applying for such license to file under oath, duly authenticated, a statement of the value of the property, or other contingency, which statement shall be kept permanently on the file. A failure on the part of the City Clerk to require their said written oath, shall be cause for suspension from office. Any person who shall make a false statement, application or oath under this section shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and punished as is hereafter set forth.

SECTION 9. Any person, firm or corporation or association that shall carry on or conduct any privilege, business, occupation or profession for which a license is required by this ordinance, without first obtaining such license, and any person who shall make a false statement, application or oath, pursuant to the foregoing section, shall, upon conviction, be punished by a fine of not less than Twenty-Five Dollars (\$25.00) nor more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) or by imprisonment not exceeding Ninety (90) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

SECTION 10. Each day that a privilege is exercised, or business, occupation, or profession conducted or followed without first having procured a license therefor, shall be an individual offense punishable as is hereinbefore set forth, provided, however, that if a person, however defined, is punished for one such offense and pays the penalty, and procures a license before further conducting or carrying on such a privilege, business, occupation or profession, then he shall not be fined for each day's failure or omission to have a license for the conducting of such a privilege, business, occupation or profession.

SECTION 11. It shall be the duty of all officers and agents of any corporation to see that such corporation complies with the provisions of this Ordinance; and all officers or agents of any corporation required by this Ordinance to be licensed which shall do business without having paid the license tax imposed and procured such license, shall be subject to the penalties imposed by the foregoing sections upon persons and members of firms and corporations violating this Ordinance.

SECTION 12. It is hereby made the duty of the City Manager to appoint a license officer with police powers, said License Officer to investigate all the aforesaid businesses, occupations or professions, and to make such inquiries as shall be necessary to determine whether they have procured a license or licenses as is herein provided for, and shall report thereon to the City Manager and the Tax Collector on each of his investigations, and when such license or licenses shall not have been procured, to make arrest of the person or persons violating this Ordinance, and any person refusing said license officer permission to investigate and inquire for the purpose of determining whether such person has such license, shall, upon conviction, be fined or imprisoned, or both fined and imprisoned, as is herein provided, for failure to procure such license.

SECTION 13. It is hereby made the duty of any person exercising the privilege or conducting a business, occupation or profession for which a license is herein required, to post his license in a conspicuous place in or about his place of business where it may be seen upon inspection by any official of said City and for his failure to do so, he shall, upon conviction, be fined or imprisoned, or both, as if he had never procured such license.

SECTION 14. The payment of a license hereunder shall not authorize or legalize in any manner whatsoever the commission of any offense or crime against said City, the County of Dade, the State of Florida, or the United States of America.

SECTION 15. No license shall be issued except in conformity with the Zoning Ordinance, No. 289, as amended.

SECTION 16. All of the provisions of this act shall be construed liberally in behalf of said City.

SECTION 17. Ordinances Nos. 311, 322, 331, 363 and all Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

SECTION 18. Should any section or part of this Ordinance be held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, such fact shall not affect the validity of other parts thereof.

SECTION 19. This Ordinance shall become effective November 1st, 1935.
