## ORDINANCE NO. 406

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 9 OF ORDINANCE NO. 402, ENTITLED "AN ORDINANE REGULATING AND RESTRICTING THE LOCATIONS WHEREIN THE BUSINESS OF THE SALE OF LIQUOR, AS HEREIN DEFINED, MAY BE CONDUCTED; PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION HEREOF AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT HEREOF."

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 9 of Ordinance No. 402 be amended so as to read as follows:
"Section 9. In "G" District the sale of liquor
is prohibited, except in golf club-houses located on standard eighteen hole golf courses."

SECTION 2. That all Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith be, and the same are, hereby repealed.
