

ORDINANCE NO. 411

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA, AMENDING ORDINANCE
NO. 384


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. That Section 2 of Ordinance No. 384, be and the
same is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2: Any and all other salaries for em-
ployees not specifically mentioned, nor covered
by this Ordinance, shall be fixed by the Depart-
ment head, with the approval of the City Manager,
and shall not exceed the sum of One Hundred
Seventy-Five (\$ 175.00) Dollars per month.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall become effective on and
after November 15th, 1935.



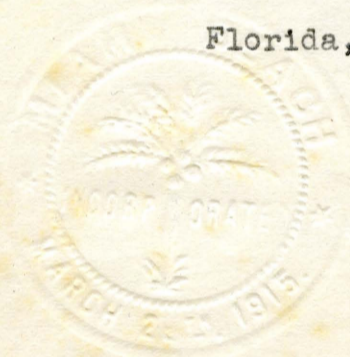
