


ORDINANCE NO. 380

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION NO. 2
OF ARTICLE NO. 10 OF ORDINANCE NO.
233 OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI
BEACH, FLORIDA, that Section 2 of Article 10 of Ordinance
No. 233 be amended to read as follows:

"Piles shall be cut off so that the tops are
below one foot (1') above mean low water. Portland
cement concrete shall be rammed into the spaces
between the heads of the piles to a depth of not
less than ten inches (10") and laterally for a dis-
tance of not less than twelve inches (12") on each
side of the rows of piles."


