## ORDINANCE NO. 379

AN ORDINANCE TO PREVENT THE UN-AUTHORIZED SELLING OF NON-TRANS-FERABLE TICKETS ISSUED BY RAILROAD OR STEAMSHIP COMPANIES AND PROVID-ING A PENALTY THEREFOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH, FLORIDA:

SECTION 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, association

of persons, firm, co-partnership or corporation to sell the unused portion or portions of non-transferable tickets issued by railroad or steamship companies, restricted to use by the original holder thereof or by the person or persons to or for whom the same was originally issued by the railroad or steamship companies issuing the same, or to act as vendor or broker of partially used non-transferable tickets issued by railroad or steamship companies, or to solicit personally or by sign or advertisement, the sale of partially used non-transferable tickets issued by railroad or steamship companies within the limits of the City of Miami Beach.

SECTION 2. Any person, association of persons, firm, co-partner-

ship or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction, for each offense, be punished by a fine of not less than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) and not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) or imprisonment in the City jail for not exceeding ten (10) days or by both such fine and imprisonment, at the discretion of the Court; and each prohibited transaction shall be deemed a separate offense and shall be punishable accordingly.
