AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA, PROVIDING FOR THE CREATION OF
THE OFFICE OF ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE
AND CHIEF OF DETECTIVES.


BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH,
FLORIDA:

That there be and there is hereby created in the
SECTION 1. City of Miami Beach the office of Assistant Chief
of Police whose duties shall be defined by the City
Manager and whose salary shall be \$200.00 per month, who shall be
appointed in accordance with the provisions of the Charter of said
City, and who shall hold office at the will of the City Manager and who
shall serve under the supervision of the Police Chief.

There is hereby created the office of Chief of De-
SECTION 2. tectives of the City of Miami Beach whose duties
shall be defined by the City Manager, whose salary
shall be \$200.00 per month, who shall be appointed in accordance
with the provisions of the Charter of said City, and who shall serve
under the supervision of the Police Chief.

All ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict
SECTION 3. herewith are hereby repealed.


