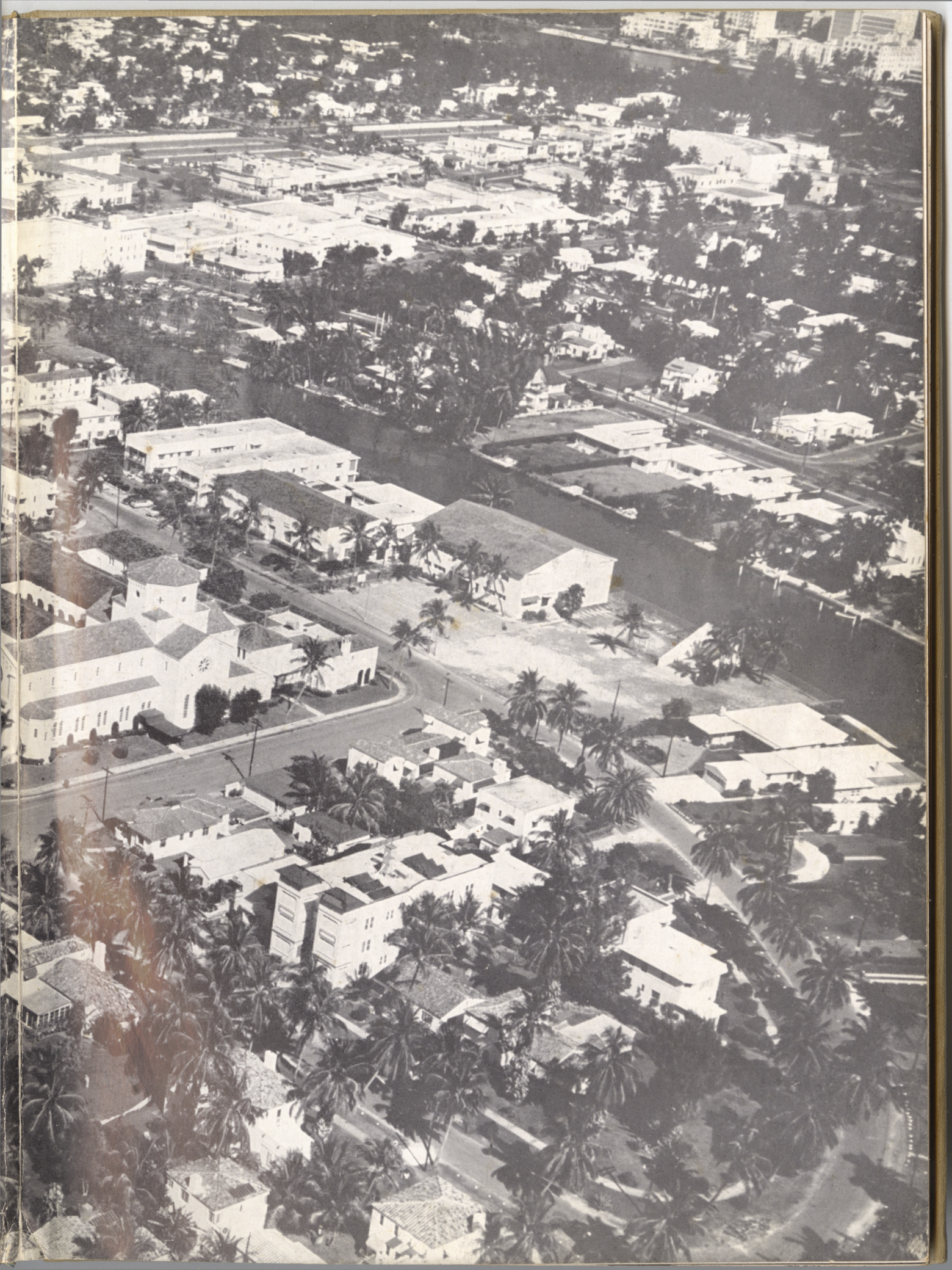

You know what we're up to with never a sign.

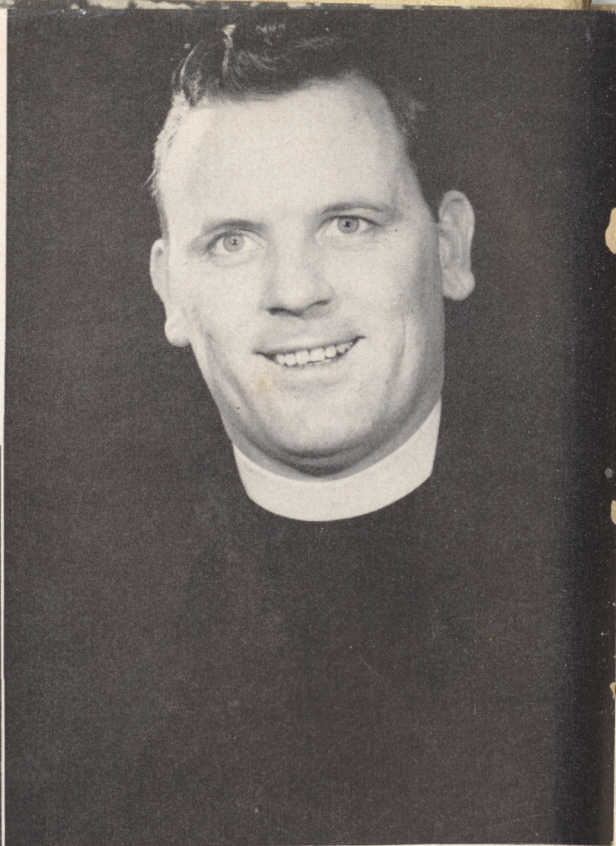
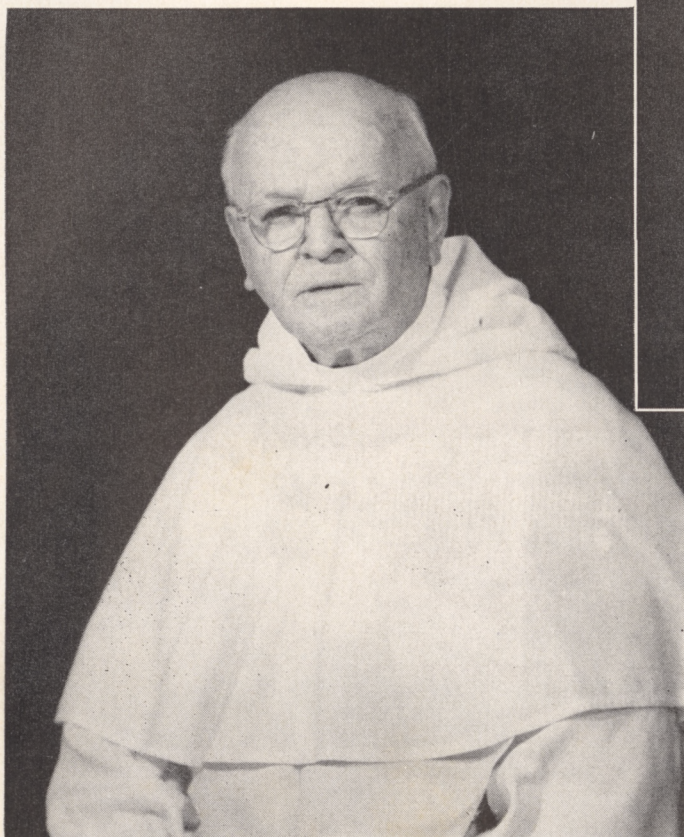
