Since receiving your favor of the 28th ult., we have been trying to find out the address of the Cape Sable Land Company. Mr. F. J. Powers, your Cape Sable Agent has just advised us the Company is represented by Mr. E. Sherrett, North Lewisburg, Ohio. I do not know what position Mr. Sherrett holds with the Company as Mr. Powers did not give us this information, but I presume he is practically in charge of the situation.

Mr. Powers says that he is trying to get a price on this land from Mr. Sherrett and hopes that you will buy the property, and that he does not want you to let Mr. Sherrett know that the Company is intending to do anything with the land that they own adjoining for fear of causing Mr. Sherrett to advance the price on his land. Perhaps Mr. Fries will be able to give you the Field Notes of both surveys, that of 1903 and 1910.
