Replying further to your message of the 20th and in conformity to my message of a few minutes ago, I am sorry to have to say that there are no Notes of the Fries survey of Flamingo on file in this office. Effort has been made from time to time to get these notes from Mr. Fries, but his reply has been, when we were able to get a reply from him, was that they had been misplaced. There are on file here two rough Tp. plats of Frae. Tp. 61 S. Rgs. 33 and 34 E. made so to speak from his survey, copies of which can be furnished you at a charge of \$1.00. These maps do not show the distances and are used simply here to keep the land entries on. There has been a survey of the Cape Sable Land Company's possessions made by said J. O. Fries in Feb. and March of the year 1910, copies of the Field Notes of which you may get by addressing said Co., but I am unable to give you their address.
