We want eight sections of land near Flamingo, Cape Sable, subdivided into 40 acre lots. These are Secs. 27-28-29-30-31-32-33-34, R.34, Twp.60, and as soon as Mr. Jenkins has finished with the two sections that he is now at work on, we want him to go down there and do this work.
