Dear Sir,-

Mr.Pepper and I went down last week to look over the north half of Township 58-38 and which Mr.F.J.Powers told us he wished to locate the parties to whom he had sold land further west who could not get on to their lands because the road to Cape Sable had not been completed to these lands. We found Mr.Livingston starting on the survey. We also found several parties plowing up the prairie land south of the pine woods who said they were associated with Mr.Fred Barrett, and that they were figuring on putting out about 400 acres in that location..

As the land had not been surveyed, I presume they were not located according to subdivisions and Mr.Powers has not written me anything on this subject, but I have written him that I presume he is arranging to sell each a tract as soon as it is surveyed. Powers wife Mr.Powers wife told us that he was at Cape Sable the day we were down there and expected him back that night.
