Dear Sir:-

In connection with the above outlined subject, for your convenience we are inclosing herewith our entire office file, under your file M-10 of the 18th inst. and are also enclosing the original plat sent you with our letter of July 15th, showing thereon in yellow outline the land which Mr. Marshall thought he wanted at that time. As before stated, the East one-half of this section was not surveyed when we made this preliminary investigation and as the land was thickly grown up with Mangrove trees and the prairie with high grass and weeds we were unable to tell where the lines should run but thought the land we looked over that day was about as indicated on the blue print mentioned; however, after the Everglades Engineering Company made their survey we discovered the land looked over and selected was that as described in our letter of August 15th, and does not figure up to quite the amount of acreage that we thought it would on the first inspection.

After the file has served your purpose, please return the same.
