Dear Sir:-

In connection with above outlined subject, we are sending you to-day under Valuable Package No. 13554, tracing of survey of E $\frac{1}{2}$  of Section 30-48-43 made by Everglades Engineering Company. To cover cost of this work we are enclosing our bill with receipt attached for \$133.75 from these people. As per arrangement with Mr. Marshall he has paid us \$66.87 on this account and you can send us voucher for the balance of \$66.88.

On going over the ground with Mr. Marshall, after the survey was completed, he wishes to have the option to purchase next Spring, providing his experiment proves out satisfactory, the SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , the E $\frac{1}{2}$  of SW $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$ , the NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{2}$ , all that part of the SW $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$  and W $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$  and NW $\frac{1}{2}$  of NE $\frac{1}{2}$  of SE $\frac{1}{2}$  lying west of right of way of the Florida East Coast Canal Company, being approximately 60 acres, at \$25.00 per acre under usual contract terms and it is also understood as per our previous correspondence that if Mr. Marshall avails himself of this purchase that he is to be allowed a credit of the first payment for this \$66.87 which he has paid towards the survey, otherwise that is to be forfeited along with his other experimental expenses to be carried on this season.
