In doing this survey work, how do you wish the East Coast Canal to be shown, i.e., just the actual width of the Canal itself, or is there any additional Right of Way that goes with it?

In making the proposed sale to Mr. Marshall of land adjoining the Canal, are we to make any Canal Right of Way reservations, or does he get these water rights.
