Dear Sir,-

Mr. McLendon said he was mailing you the 1918 tax statements for your various companies but did not make up any statements covering the Southern Drainage District. He said the Trustees of this District had just delivered to him a tax roll for the year 1918 for an annual installment tax and that this tax was assessed, so he understood, according to the amount of benefit received by each tract of land in the District. In looking through this tax roll we note that the Model Land Co. and Perrine Grant Land Co. have lands that have been assessed for this annual installment tax. You will recall that last year this District made a uniform assessment of 25 cents an acre on all the lands in the District as a preliminary tax regardless of the benefit received.
