Bright and Watson were present matters in general, but nothing in particular were discussed, and as we were informed that State Drainage Engineer, Elliott was in this Section and would be invited and expected to be present at a regular meeting of the Supervisors of the Broward Drainage District at Ft. Lauderdale at 10:00 A. M., next Monday the 8th, Mr. Bright and Mr. Watson, Supervisors invited as many as possible of the Land Owners League to be present at that meeting and bring up for discussion any questions they cared to.

I have always been interested personally to see something done to get our back country drained and reclaimed and therefore try to attend as many of these meetings as possible, and of course it goes without saying that I always use my best judgment in protecting the best interests of your Companies. While I realize you have always paid your taxes which would indicate you were in sympathy with the drainage project, on the other hand there seems to be more or less contention or misunderstanding at the present time between some of the land owners and the Supervisors of the Broward Drainage District, and I am not quite certain of just what policy you would like pursued, and whether or not it is your desire that I should act as your representative in these meetings, and if so and there is any special line along which you wish me to work I wish you would please get work to me so I will have it by Monday morning.

Of course you understand, as above stated, I would in any event use my best judgment in protecting your interest and keep you advised of anything of importance that was transpiring, but what I am after now is if you have any special policy to let me know what it is so that I will be posted and can place my efforts to the best advantage.
