Dear Mr. Pepper:- A request somewhat out of the ordinary, writing at Mr. Dewhurst's request. Powers reports that during very high stages of water in the Cape Sable Section, the waters, in that part of Trps 59 & 60, Rgs. 35 through which the Ingraham Highway is now very near to, and will cross during its progress over the two or three next miles, the waters flow to the eastward; though during ordinary stages the flow is westward. If these conditions do actually exist, it would appear to be the proper thing to have the roadway thrown to the west side of the Canal before entering upon these lower grounds.

Mr. Dewhurst wishes to know if you can find out through Mr. Truman what the actual conditions are.
