Dear Sir:-

I have your favor of the 30th ult., stating that Mr. Wright, who is anxious to take up the Whelan Option, is in Miami, and that he has been to Cape Sable with Garthside, also that Mr. Stanton has not turned up as yet.

I wired you on yesterday the substance of a telegram from Mr. Larson to myself, advising that Mr. Stanton had stopped over in New Orleans, which accounts for his not arriving at Homestead as expected; therefore, should he now desire to purchase any lands at Cape Sable he will have to do so under some other arrangement than the Whelan Contract.

Relative to my wire that James would be in Miami on the 2nd with Mr. Youngs, beg to advise that Mr. Youngs is a party who was originally associated with Mr. Allen in the purchase of Cape Sable Lands, but he has now decided to go to the Cape and look over the lands with a view of purchasing and, as I understand it, has cut loose from his former associates. Mr. Youngs is also from Lakeland, Fla., and Mr. Powers can inform you fully as to him.
