Dear Sir:-

In reply to your telegram of the 30th inst. we
wired you as follows:

"Powers due in Saint Augustine can tell you
about Wright. Stanton has not shown up."

We wrote you yesterday, which letter you have
probably received, telling you that Mr. Powers expected to
be in St. Augustine to-day, etc. Wright is here; he went
to the Cape with Garthside who had a sick wife and did not
want to stay at the Cape any length of time and we judge that
he will not go back to the Cape until Garthside's wife is
better. We have not heard of Stanton here and telephoned Mr.
Powers' office this afternoon and they have not heard of him
in Homestead.

We note that James is to be in Miami on the 2nd
with Youngs. We do not know who Youngs is.
