Mr. Pepper and I, in going down the Ingraham Highway as far as the present dredge, within a few days past noticed that wood was being cut on Company land in Sections 4 and 5 of Township 58-38 for the dredge working on the road to Cape Sable. We have not issued any permit for this purpose and have not been notified that your office has issued any such permit.

When Mr. Dewhurst was here last he asked us our judgment about letting the dredge have lighterwood for 25¢ a cord because of the long haul to the dredge, so possibly he may know something about this matter.
