Dear Mr. Blackwell, -

We are just in receipt of a letter from Mr. Ingraham regarding the distribution of Southern District Drainage taxes on their books.

He states that they have already paid the Perrine Grant Land Company taxes in your District for 1922 amounting to \$487.92 and that they have in their office a statement of the Model Land Company taxes in your District, same amounting to \$793.72.

When Mr. Hill made up his tax books for the year 1922 he generally assessed to these Companies all of the land they owned in any one Section and then in many cases, only a few acres were in your Drainage District, and consequently Mr. Ingraham's office is unable to distribute on their books the Southern Drainage taxes against the land that is in the District and for which you made up a tax statement for Mr. Hill's use.

Therefore, Mr. Ingraham has requested us to ask you to make up a statement of all of the property in your District owned by the Model Land Company and the Perrine Grant Land Company, giving the amount of taxes assessed against each tract so that they can make the proper distribution on their books.

He would like to have this data as quickly as possible, especially for the reason that he has already paid the Perrine Grant Land Company taxes and is unable to make proper charge on his books.
