BROWARD DRAINAGE DISTRICT:

Dear Mr. Harrison:

I have your letter of the 22nd inst., on the above subject, and am sorry that my letter of the 19th, was confusing. Instead of the word Section it should of course have been Township, as mentioned by you, and the acreage should have been somewhere in the neighborhood of 8468.70 in the place of 5823.

In the second paragraph of the second page of my letter the lands to be assessed 50% less than the balance of the lands in the District are Section 34 of 47-41 and Sections 4, 10, 14, 28 and 34 of 48-41, and as stated, Section 26 of 49-41 and 2 of 50-41 are within the bounds of Unit #1 and will take a full assessment along with the rest of the lands in this Unit.

The landowners had a very interesting and profitable meeting with the Commissioners on last Wednesday, the 16th, and unan- imously approved of the manner and method in which they are doing their work and passed a resolution to that effect which will accom- pany their report when made to the Court.

I am enclosing an article published by the Metropolis of yesterday giving a very good account of the meeting.
