Dear Mr. Pepper:

I have your favor of the 29th ulto. and thank you very much indeed for the exhaustive explanation you have given me in regard to this matter.

From the facts stated to us by Mr. Tom M. Bryan and assertions made by him we were very much of the opinion that we had made a very grave error in consenting to the nomination and election of Mr. R.
