Dear Sir :-

On January 19th. you asked us to secure from the Southern Drainage District an itemized statement of the taxes paid by you for the year 1922 on lands owned by the Perrine Grant Land Company and also a statement of taxes in this district to be paid by the Model Land Company for the year 1922 so as to enable you to distribute the taxes against each 5 and 10 acre tract.

We immediately took this matter up with Mr. Blackwell, Secretary of the Southern Drainage District and he said he would furnish a statement to us but so far we have been unable to get the statement from him, although, we have called his attention to this matter several times, the last time being about two weeks ago. If he has not made up a statement and mailed it direct to you, then I wish you would write us a letter calling attention to the fact that you have not received the statement and stating that it is necessary that you have same and that your inability to get the statement is giving your office a great deal of inconvenience. Please write such a letter that we may show to Mr. Blackwell and then if the statement is not forthcoming we will take the matter up with the President of the Drainage District.

In your letter of January 19th. you also asked us to get for you the same information covering Goulds Special Drainage District and I spoke to Mr. R. L. Hill's office about furnishing such a statement for you and his office advised me a few days after our request that he had made up the statement and mailed direct to you.
